3 DAYS OF WONDER

DEVON'S YOUNG REBELS... WITH A CAUSE

Devon's own 3 Days of Wonder are more than just a rising force in the local rock scene—they're a band with a mission. Frontman Luke Notman isn't just passionate about making music; he's determined to give back to the venues that helped shape his journey. With independent music spaces struggling to stay afloat, Luke has a bold idea: putting on a gig to raise funds for the Music Venue Trust, an organization dedicated to protecting grassroots music venues across the UK.

We caught up with Luke to talk about his vision for the event, why small venues matter, and how 3 Days of Wonder plans to make a difference. If you love live music and want to support the scene, this is one interview you don't want to miss!

So, Luke tells us what prompted you to approach Tracie at The Barrel House with the idea of putting on a gig to raise funds for the Music Venue Trust (MVT)?

As a grass roots band, we are knee deep in trying to book gigs locally and slightly further afield. Pretty quickly I figured that the number of quality venues open to hosting original bands was fairly limited and this led me to explore the MVT and MVP socials and find out more. I discovered a really challenging situation and decided to show my support by committing some of my hard-earned gig money to MVP community shares for investment into grassroots music venues. I knew that I wanted to do more though and landed on the idea of putting on a fundraising gig. That week one of those serendipitous moments happened; on one post from the MVT Venues Day in October, I saw Tracie being interviewed about the challenges being faced by the Barrel House Ballroom and GMVS. That's when the fundraiser was cemented in my mind, and I reached out; luckily Tracie was up doing a fundraising gig at The Barrel House Ballroom!

What does the Barrel House Ballroom mean to you?

The Barrel House Ballroom is such an iconic local venue. It is a beautiful space that celebrates performance of all types, filled with the most incredible community of supporters, staff and talented folk. It is one of those places that gives a real earthy hug and provides a hugely safe environment to learn and hone your craft. An amazing place for people to be truly creative. Our family and friends have talked about it as a place that was part of their growing up, enjoying sweaty gigs with the whole floor literally bouncing!

Can you tell us about the first time you performed there?

I remember this really well as I performed at the Barrel House Ballroom for the first time as a 15-year-old through the Jamming Station initiative. It was the first time I'd performed in a band on a stage with lights and a sound engineer and to be honest was completely blown away by the setting and the response from the huge number of people that came out to support us!

And what's been one of your favourite gigs to attend there?

Recently, I watched the extraordinary John Bramwell, the lead singer of 'I am Kloot'. I loved how comfortable he was in his own skin, story-telling and having a wonderful time performing. I laughed and smiled at his authentic stories of being on the road, whilst having total admiration for his musical prowess.

How did the name 3 Days of Wonder come about?

We get asked this a lot! It comes from Rudyard Kipling and his reflections on his 3 days in

Burma, which he described as '3 Days of Wonder' and inspired him to write the poem 'Mandalay'. When writing I try to emulate some of the sense of escapism that he painted in his poetry.

Who do you take inspiration from?

Musically and in terms of performance, artists such as: Bruce Springsteen, Bono and Roger Daltry. Emotionally, from my family... they have supported me every step of the way with all of my performances.

What's the creative process for the band when you sit down to write a song?

I love the symbiotic relationship that we strike as a band and with our songwriting. Finn, the guitarist normally writes a hook or a riff which he then builds into the music that becomes the song— he's hugely prolific in getting these out. I then place down the lyric/story and the melody. Charlie on bass and Dan are both very talented musicians and then it's over to them to lay down a killer backline with all of us giving constructive feedback along the way.

If you could conjure up a dream creative collaboration, whom would it be with?

The Eagles (original line-up) would be an absolute dream.

What's in store for you over the next year and what are you most looking forward to?

We've got an exciting few months ahead. We are supporting the Ultra Violets on their south coast tour and will be playing some wicked festivals over the summer including Great Estate, Shebfest, Kindred Spirits Festival and then playing in some amazing grass roots music venues like the Barrel House, The Junction, The Cavern, Bomba, The Palladium Club and the Moor Beer Brewery. We've got heaps of songs ready to professionally record and really looking forward to getting enough money together to be able to fund this process.

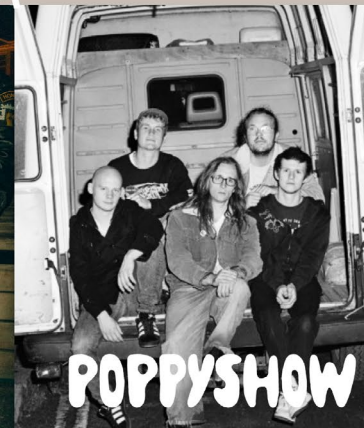
