UNPLUGGED WITH...

ROMEO STODART

PAST, PRESENT, AND THE ROAD AHEAD

Best known as the distinctive voice and songwriter behind Magic Numbers, Romeo Stodart has carved out an equally compelling path as a solo artist. Blending the heartfelt lyricism and melodic warmth that first won him a loyal following with a more intimate, personal sound, his solo work offers a fresh perspective on an already celebrated career. We caught up with Romeo to talk about stepping into the spotlight alone, finding inspiration in new places, and why songwriting remains at the heart of everything he does.

Totnes has a famously independent and creative music community. Have you played here or spent time in South Devon before, and what do you enjoy about playing towns away from the usual big-city touring circuit?

Yes, I honestly cannot wait! I'm a beach boy really as I was born in the Caribbean. My favourite memories as a kid growing up in Trinidad & Tobago ones at the beach with my family. I feel transported back there whenever I'm near the coast. I loved the very few times we've been to South Devon over the years as a band and solo. I'm hoping to see more this time around though as I have a week free before the first show at the Barrel House. I'm very excited about this little solo adventure as it does allow me to explore a bit more and visit different places.

The Magic Numbers' debut album came out over 20 years ago and became a million-selling, Mercury Prize-nominated record. When you look back at that period now, what memories stand out most?

To be honest it was a whirlwind of dreams coming true, moments we never thought would ever happen. A rollercoaster of heightened emotions, mainly joy mixed with fear. I remember holding our debut 7 inch Hymn For Her in my hands for the very first time, our music on vinyl with the Heavenly Records bird logo. Wow, it's real, this is happening! That moment preceded a residency of 3 shows at The Borderline in London where we heard the crowd sing our songs back at us for the first time, they were loud, we kept looking at each other. That experience shared together was so special. Then there's some mad ones like singing harmonies with Brian Wilson on Love & Mercy live

on his UK tour, that was a definite pinch yourself moment, Glastonbury Pyramid Stage was insane, so many people but every Glastonbury show's been pretty crazy special for us, touring Japan playing The Budokan, South America was and continues to be one of the most amazing places to play. The people are just sweetie pies, so warm.

After five Magic Numbers albums and so many other musical projects, has your relationship with songwriting changed as you've got older? What excites you creatively these days?

I'm absolutely loving the piano. It's a true love affair. I'm still trying for that left hand to have full independence so I can do all the things I hear in my head. I'm a slow reader and impatient but all that sheet music I buy in charity shops needs to be played. My relationship with music has intensified if anything. Having a little studio at home is a dream as it's just where I want to be, making things, having fun exploring sound, engineering. I do love playing live though and miss sharing music, it's still a thrill and there's lots of new music to play.

Your guitar playing has a very distinctive character. Who were the guitarists or musicians who first made you want to pick up an instrument and find your own sound?

Thank you, that's kind of you to say. Well initially as a kid of 11 or 12 I wanted to be Slash, I just thought he looked super cool, they all did and Appetite For Destruction was the first album I ever bought. An important album for all of us in The Magic Numbers believe it or not, but as much as I loved heavy metal as a young teenager I was also drawn to The Smiths and The Cure, bands that I could relate to feeling like the weirdo outsider kid that I was. I loved both Johnny Marr's style and Robert Smith's guitar playing which I think is very underrated.

You've been part of Damon Albarn's Africa Express collective since its early days. What did those experiences teach you about making music with people from very different musical backgrounds?

I hold those experiences as invaluable, they serve as a reminder not to get in the way. For me, music is a blessing, it's a special thing, a place you can truly let go of everything and be carried. When you improvise you're following the music essentially, you have to tune into the feeling, the spell of it, listen and it takes you there.

I visit that place as I go there on my own meditatively playing freely but to do that together with people, it's everything! To go there with unbelievable musicians with so much heart and warmth and their understanding and respect for that place and exchange with one another is just the best feeling ever. Playing guitar with Amadou for hours and hours, two guitars, two huge smiles, no words. The joy I felt from that was immense. I'll be forever grateful to Damon for getting the chance to go to Nigeria and play music for a week nonstop and meet amazing people. I never wanted it to end. Playing with the late great Tony Allen in many crazy situations, on stage at The Shrine with him and Flea on bass, tonnes of insane musicians jumping on and off, feeling that rhythm! Maddest gig, intense, it was 7 hours long, from erupting the crowd with all improvisational jams to some moments falling flat being on the receiving end of boos and jeering. Epic. You learn fast. I am a huge Fela Kuti fan so that was a dream beyond. Aw Tony, getting to hang out with him and have a big smoke. His smile. Treasured memory.

Finally, what's on the horizon for you? Any new music, collaborations, or exciting projects in the pipeline?

Excited to say that a new Magic Numbers album will be out in the new year. It's been far too long. I'm also recording a duo album with Ren Harvieu which we can't wait for people to hear. The songs have gone down so well at the shows we've done. Her new album will be out before though and it's a must! Lots of touring in the pipeline for next year as the Magic Numbers and also solo shows which I'm really enjoying.

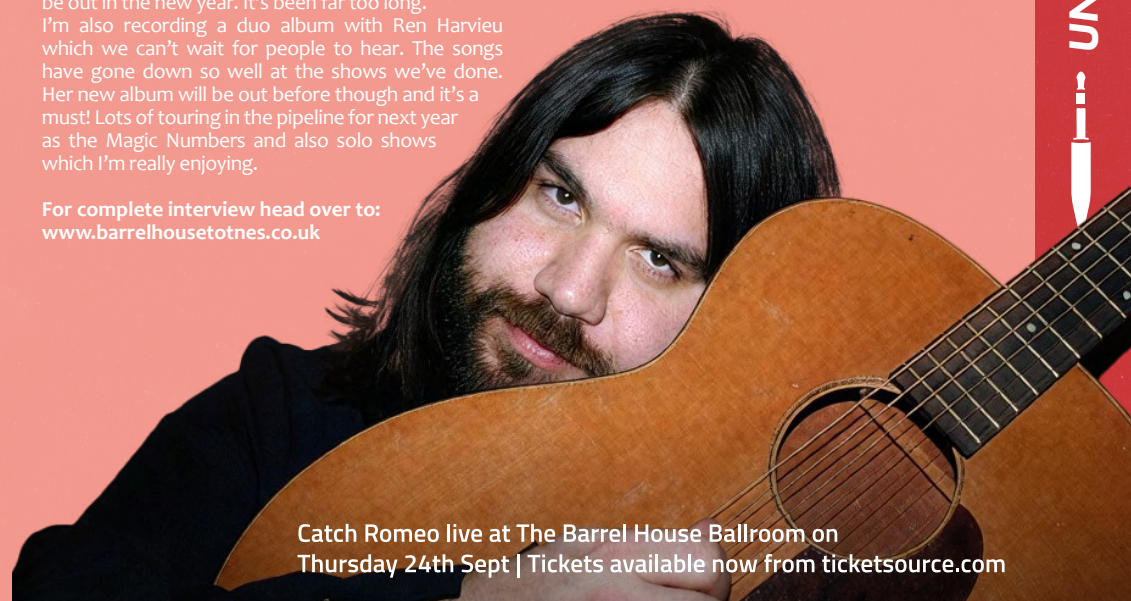

FOUR DAYS OF QUEER JOY, 24-27 SEPTEMBER

After a hiatus since 2023, Totnes Pride is back - bigger than ever before and open to all – queers and allies. This September, a four-day arts, culture and community celebration spreads across Totnes and Dartington, taking in places venues from the Barrel House Ballroom to Totnes Cinema, Angel Space, Eastgate Bookshop and St Mary's Church.

Run by a not-for-profit community collective, Totnes Pride 2026 brings together live music, art, film, workshops, wellbeing, family and youth activities, and plenty of nightlife - all under this year's theme, Queer Joy. Expect everything from a queer poets "Sunday Service" and a Queer Islands Disc's request show, to a queer makers market, live performance, a unique live music gig to a very "Totnes Twist" on the traditional Pride march.

Barrel House is proud to be part of it. Across the weekend we're hosting Queer Angels (our regular monthly social), a Queer-oke., the Big Queer Joy Party bringing together 3 stellar queer DJs for one massive dance floor filler, a queer jazz set from Mama Tokus, and the Queer Talents Open Mic to close out the weekend.

Totnes Pride is entirely volunteer powered and not for profit and every ticket and donation goes straight back into artist fees, venue costs and making sure young people have free, safe spaces to celebrate who they are.

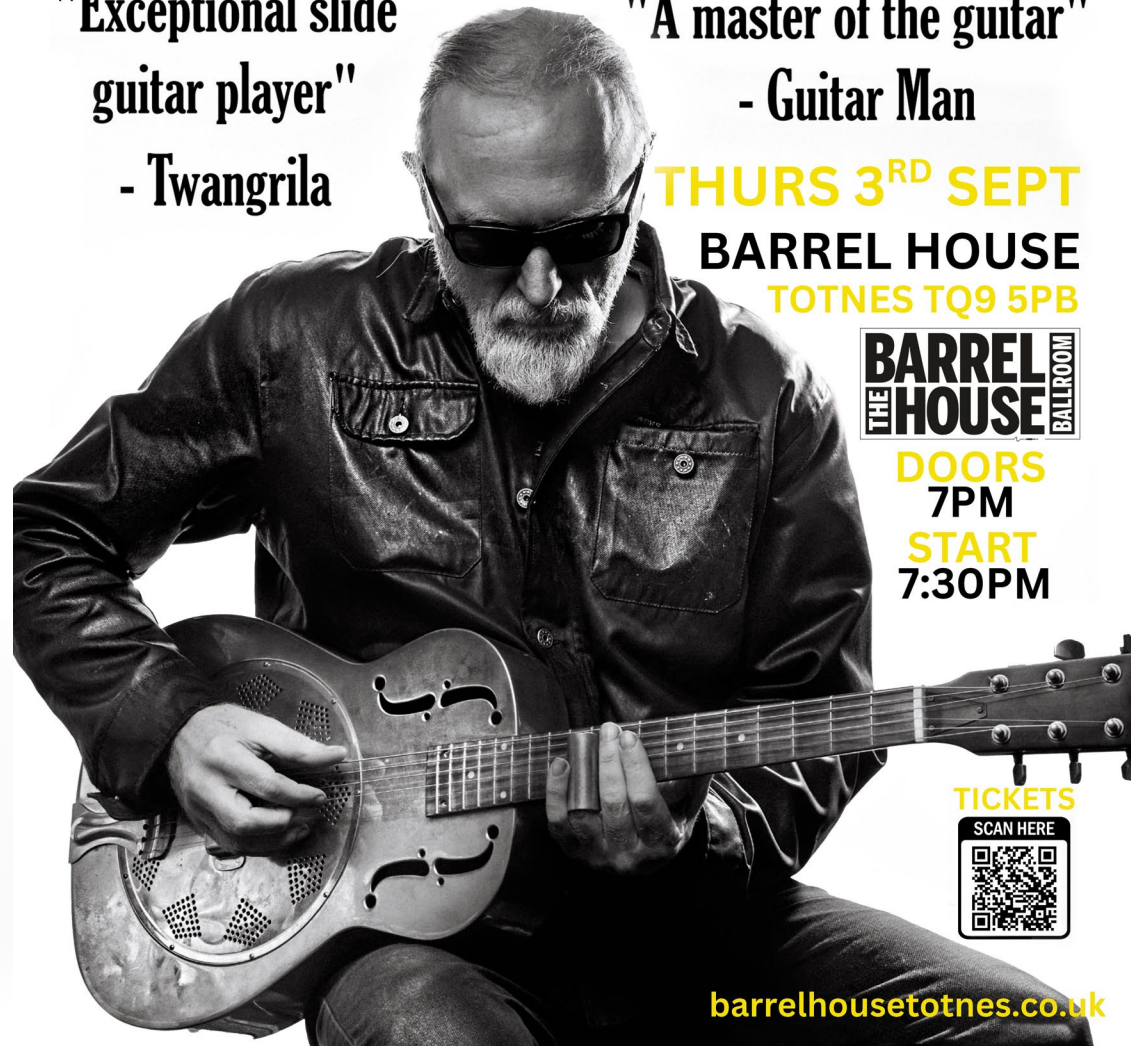
